

SPRAY-ON SNOW ART

This at-home activity is provided by Calgary Public Library to help you and your family have a fun and engaging winter together, both at home and out in the community.

Enjoy this simple, hands-on activity to create art in the snow.

MATERIALS TO FIND AT HOME

- Warm water
- More spray bottles (optional)
- Kool-Aid packet
- Bottle
- Spray nozzle

ACTIVITY INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Add one packet of Kool-Aid to the bottle.
- 2. Fill the bottle with warm water. Screw the spray nozzle onto the bottle.
- 3. Shake the bottle until the Kool-Aid is dissolved.
- 4. Spray the colour on the snow to start your snow painting. If you don't use it all, put the rest into another container for later.
- Take the spray nozzle off the bottle and rinse it out, then create another colour from the other Kool-Aid packet or save it for another time.

You can also try the following:

- Use food colouring instead of Kool-Aid for more snow-painting fun.
- Attach a large sheet of paper to the side of your house or fence, paint on it, then, using just water in the spray bottle, spray your painting for a cool, rain-washed effect.
